WORKERS REGISTRATION BOARD PRACTISING LICENCE REFRESHER  
COURSE

Further to correspondence dated 20 September 2006 concerning the  
Electrical Workers Registration Board's practising licence refresher course.

At its January 2007 meeting the Board considered a report produced by an  
independent facilitator and agreed that the report be released to all persons  
who attended the industry meeting on 16 October 2006 and to all persons  
who made written submissions on the practising licence refresher course.

Board response to the report

Following full consideration of the independent facilitator's report the Board  
has:

- (a) noted the areas of consensus contained in the report and will take these aspects into consideration in any future review, and
- (b) agreed that the consulted "Practising Licence Refresher Course" document dated 26 June 2006 should be renamed a course prescription and be applicable to the electrical inspector/electrician categories of practising licences, and
- (c) agreed to produce course prescriptions for the electrical service technician levels "A" and "B" and line mechanic categories of practising licences, and
- (d) agreed that the above mentioned electrical service technician and line mechanic course prescriptions will be based on the consulted

“Practising Licence Refresher Course” document dated 26 June 2006, and

- (e) agreed that the independent facilitator’s report will be placed on the Board’s website at [www.ewrb.govt.nz](http://www.ewrb.govt.nz) and a summary of the report will be included in the March 2007 issue of the Board’s ELECTRON newsletter.
