APPLICATION for a Provisional Licence

Information for Applicants

Note:

1. Most Provisional Licences are issued with limitations, which can include one or more of the following:
 - (a) limited to carrying out certain prescribed electrical work;
 - (b) working on approved premises;
 - (c) working for an approved employer;
 - (d) not being able to supervise non registered persons
 - (e) not being able to test and certify wiring installation work unless such testing and certification is done under the supervision of:
 - (i) a registered electrical inspector
 - (ii) a registered electrician who is entitled to test and certify wiring installation work.
 - (f) being supervised by a supervisor of electrical work. (See Note 3.)
2. When an applicant is to be supervised by a person who is not the applicants employer, sections 6 and 7 must be completed. This applies if the supervisor is also the employer.
3. A supervisor of electrical work is a registered person
 - (a) whose registration allows them to carry out the prescribed electrical work they are supervising;
 - (b) who has at least 3 years post registration experience;
 - (c) who is competent to carry out the prescribed electrical work they are supervising;
 - (d) who holds a current practising licence.
4. The Board may decline an application for a Provisional Licence
 - (a) where an applicant has previously held such a licence but did not pass or attempt to pass the required examination during the currency of that licence;
 - (b) from an applicant who has previously held a number of Provisional Licences.

Payment of Fees

1. The fee for a Provisional Licence is \$34.00 inc. GST.
2. Payment must accompany each application.
3. All cheques must be made payable to the Electrical Workers Registration Board.
4. If you are paying by cheque please check that you have signed it.
5. We do not accept, Bankcard, Diners Club or American Express.
6. If paying by credit card, please check that you have entered card type, number and expiry date correctly. Your bank requires you to sign the credit card panel seperately.
