1. Introduction

This is a guide to assist EWRB approved competence programme providers *Add Competence Training* using the EWRB website portal. The online update system addresses problems with paper based system by:

- Accurately identifying trainees who are registered electrical workers.
- Instantly updating electrical worker records with details of training provided.
- Reducing competence programme provider administration overheads.
- Eliminating rework arising from incorrect / incomplete information on spread sheets.

2. User Roles on the EWRB Website Portal

Everyone who accesses the EWRB website portal logins using RealMe. RealMe is the Government's login and identity verification system. There are several reasons why people access the EWRB website portal. Access is setup to reflect these roles and present appropriate menu options:

- Licenced electrical worker.
- Licensed employer.
- Employers of electrical workers.
- Approved provider of tuition and assessments for Board examinations.
- Approved competence programme provider.

One RealMe login is required for each role, for example if you are a licensed electrical worker and an approved competence programme provider you will need a RealMe login for each of these roles.

3. Logins for Approved Competence Programme Providers

The process to become a provider of competence programmes is set out in the Boards Practising Licence and Competence Programme rules published on its website <u>here</u>.¹ Approved competence programme providers are required to enter into an agreement with the Board and are recorded on the Boards website. Access to the website portal is achieved by using a RealMe login (created specifically for this purpose). The login is linked to the providers records in website portal by entering an activation code supplied by the Board. If you don't know your activation code, email us at <u>info@ewrb.govt.nz</u> for assistance. We cannot give out passwords and activation codes over the phone.

4. Competence Programme Provider Profile

The *Organisations Home* page of the website portal differs from the EWRB electrical worker *Home* page of website portal.



Click on *Organisation Profile* to view / edit your contact details and select from the range of service available. Changing your address here automatically updates Board records, but does not update the list of competence programme providers on the website. Email <u>info@ewrb.govt.nz</u> if you wish to change your details published on the Boards website.

The Licence Details, Employee Details, Employee Relicence Competency Training and Employee Relicence Payment are not relevant for competence programme providers and should not be used. If your organisation is also an employer of licenced electrical workers you will probably need a separate login for that. Do not confuse other roles with your work as a competence programme provider.

Start by creating your course details. Enter date completed and course type² from the list:

- First Aid
- CPR
- Site Safe
- Electrical Safety and Testing

Then locate and add electrical workers to the course you have created. You can search by:

- Full name; or
- Licence number (accepts multiple entries separated by a comma); or
- EW ID number

Multiple searches only work when the licence number on an electrical workers card is entered. Format your search string with a space between letters and numbers and a comma between each electrical worker (for example: Im 259343,eas 259408,e 17735).

Note: Licence numbers have a gap between letters and numbers. EW ID numbers do not have a gap between letters and numbers.

Search for unlicensed people (for example the holder of a trainee limited certificate) by full name.

Sight and confirm each electrical worker. Uncheck the tick box for electrical workers you do not wish to add to your course.

Note that errors (for example incorrect licence numbers) are reported in the yellow error message box.



² The Registrar expects competence programme providers to deliver appropriate training. Please select the closest type of training from the list.

If you cannot find a course participant try searching for them on the Electrical Worker Register <u>here</u>³. Competence programme providers are not responsible for the actions of course participants, however we would appreciate trainers drawing the attention of people who have attended training, but are not on the Boards database to the trainees page⁴ of the Boards website with specific reference to the requirements for obtaining a trainee limited certificate. Training information cannot be recorded for a person who is not on the system. In this situation competence programme providers should produce a certificate of completion that can be presented to the Registrar at a later date.
